Caring for Daylilies · Best to buy varieties that you have seen blooming in a northern garden

- · Look past the flower, look for bud count
 - · Look for branching, flowers are better displayed on many branches

Purchasing

- · Dormant foliage for the most hardiness
- · Has the variety won any awards? Gardens judges have chosen them.

- · Full sun to part shade
- · Well drained soils; may need to amend clay
- · Fairly drought-tolerant
- Mulch
- Deadheading
- · Reinvigorate by dividing
