The North Dakota Department of Human Services can assist individuals who need help addressing stress, anxiety and depression in healthy ways, or who may need assistance with food, heating, child care, and health care coverage. If things are reaching a crisis, we may be able to help.

- Crisis Help If you are in crisis, call our confidential behavioral health crisis lines 24-hours per day, seven days a week or go to a regional human service center or one of their outreach offices during business hours for immediate help.
- Open Access (walk-in) behavioral health assessments Walk-in during Open Access hours for mental health and addiction assessment and triage services, and if needed, get connected to help right away. Crisis walk-ins are always welcome during business hours, not just Open Access hours.
- Substance Use Disorder Voucher Program Get help with the cost of addiction treatment and recovery services from participating providers, if you qualify.
- Economic Assistance Programs If you are need help affording food and other basics, apply.
